MAY 2013 ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

Status as of April 5, 2013

ARTICLE 29 - FUND LIBRARY TECHNOLOGY

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds or borrow a sufficient sum of money to purchase technology hardware and software for Brooks Free Library and to act fully thereon. By request of the Brooks Free Library Board of Trustees. Estimated Cost: \$29,000.

Status: The Board of Selectmen and Finance Committee have voted support for this article.

ARTICLE 20 - INSTALL VENTING AND AIR CONDITIONING IN LIBRARY BASEMENT

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds or borrow a sufficient sum of money to install an exhaust vent system for the Electrical Room and air conditioning for the Computer Room and Electrical Room at the Brooks Free Library and to act fully thereon. By request of the Brooks Free Library Board of Trustees. Estimated Cost: \$7,600.

Status: Exhaust venting is being installed now using funds in this year's budget so the cost is no longer included in the article. Town Meeting will be asked to transfer \$7600 for the air conditioning work from the balance remaining in the May 2011 Annual Town Meeting article to reconfigure the Library parking lot and install lighting in the parking lot.

ARTICLE 31 - FUND LIBRARY BUILDING MAINTENANCE PROJECTS

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds or borrow a sufficient sum of money to fund interior maintenance including but not limited to painting and carpet/flooring replacement at Brooks Free Library and to act fully thereon. By request of the Brooks Free Library Board of Trustees. Estimated Cost: \$75,000.

Status: - A source of funding has not yet been identified for this work.

ARTICLE 32 - FUND BROOKS FREE LIBRARY PHASE II RESTORATION AND PRESERVATION, HISTORIC "BANK BUILDING"

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds or borrow a sufficient sum of money to fund Phase II restoration and preservation - historic Bank Building at Brooks Free Library and to act fully thereon. By request of the Brooks Free Library Board of Trustees. Estimated Cost: \$38,000.

Status: This project was not approved for CPA funds by the Community Preservation Committee but it remains on the Annual Town Meeting warrant seeking other Town funds. A source of funding has not yet been identified for this work.
