Use of Commissary Agreement Base of Operations

It is required that the operator of a Mobile Food unit have a base of operation from a licensed commissary/shared kitchen facility. Home kitchens will not be approved. The kitchen is an essential part of a mobile food operation and must have facilities for supply storage, potable water, equipment cleaning and sanitizing, food preparation, effuse, water and grease disposal and other servicing activities. No food used on a mobile food unit shall be stored at a home residence.
