



VOTED: That the Traffic Rules and Orders of the Town of Harwich adopted by the Board of Selectmen July 1, 1940 and subsequent amendments thereto be and are hereby amended as follows:

By adding at the end of Article 5, Section 2, Prohibited on Certain Streets, the following description:

NO PARKING both sides of Chase Street, West Harwich from Pleasant Road southwesterly approximately 212 feet and Pleasant Road southerly approximately 150 feet as per enclosed plan.


