What is “gently used”?

Most Halloween costumes will show some minor signs of wear. However, we cannot use costumes that have prominent stains or tears. Remember that your donated costume is supposed to help a child feel special and confident on Halloween, so it should be in good shape.

Do you take partial costumes or dress-up accessories?

Yes! As long as they are in “gently used” condition, we can always put random costume parts -- such as tutus, masks, or capes -- to good use.

Do I have to label or package my donated costumes?

It's really helpful if you include a note with your costume that tells us the age it's appropriate for, what size it is, and what it's supposed to be (superheroes, princesses, ect. ). Including the costumes original package or a hanger and plastic garment bag makes it so much easier for us to store the costume, but we accept good costumes without those items.
