MINUTES BOARD OF SELECTMEN WALKING TOUR OF ROUTE 124 FRIDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2013 11:00 A.M.

The meeting convened at 11:00 a.m. in the Town Hall parking lot at which time the Board proceeded by car to the Cape Cod Regional Technical High School parking lot. The Selectmen then walked the entire length of the section under review for the Route 124 Transportation Improvement Project with Highways and Maintenance Director Lincoln Hooper. They were joined by several neighbors during the walk and took part in the discussions.

Mr. Hooper pointed out where the road would be along the route and answered a variety of questions concerning the proposed project from the Selectmen and the public. He noted the following:

- The road is not going to be a straight through but will remain curved in order to take advantage of Town land "right of way."
- Only a small section of the bike path will be moved and that is by the Harwich/Brewster line.
- There will be no movement of the bike path where it abuts the small private beaches.
- The sidewalk will only go from Cape Cod Regional Technical School to the start of the bike path. The sidewalk does not go from the bike path to the Town line.
- The land to be used for the shoulders and sidewalks are on either Town or State land.
- The Town has permission from DOT to use 4 foot shoulders rather than 5 foot shoulders as well as to use the bike path as a sidewalk.

The tour ended at 12:45 p.m.
