B. Sisson Road Fuel Spill

Superintendent Pelletier updated the Board on the fuel spill that occurred on Sisson Road. A battery of water samples were taken to test for different contaminants, none were detected. Neither the water service nor the hydrant at the location were compromised.

C. Sustainable Planting Initiative in Eversource ROW

Food Forest Initiative presented during Public Comment, their idea regarding planting sustainable plantings in the Eversource ROW on Bay Rd.

D. Harwich Cranberry Festival Fireworks

The Board discussed the Chapter 22 By-Law regarding the 1500' buffer for fireworks. The Board is aware of the By-Law and supports having the Harwich Cranberry Festival fireworks in Whitehouse Field.

A. FY21-27 Seven Year Capital Plan Due 9/29/19

The FY21-27 Seven Year Capital Plan is due on September 20, 2019. If modifications are to be made, they will have to be done within the next couple of weeks.

B. FY21 Budget / Warrant Timeline
