## PERPETUAL CARE.

By a vote passed at a lawful meeting of the Corporation, held Jan. 11, 1902, the Trustees of the East Harwich Cemetery Corporation were authorized to receive from the proprietor or proprietors of lots, a sum of money not less than Seventy-five Dollars, for the repair, preservation or embellishment of their lots or the erections thereon, and the Board of Trustees shall give the proprietor or proprietors of such lots an agreement, binding the Corporation to expend the income in the repair, preservation and improvement of such lot, and the erections thereon forever.
