Dear Sirs:

I am sending this date to Capt. Darius Weeks Secretary and Treasurer of the South Barnstable Cemetery, bank books of the Cape Cod Five Cents Savings Bank of Barnstable Mass. No. 22422 and No. 22423 with deposits of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150. #) on each book, total three hundred dollars (\$300. #).

The income that accrues on bank book No. 22422 is to be used for the perpetual care of the burial lot in the South Barnstable Cemetery of Joseph P. and Almira Nickerson, and the income that accrues on bank book No. 22423 is to be used for the perpetual care of the burial lot in the South Barnstable Cemetery of James and Loretta Loveland.

The yearly assessments of the South Barnstable Cemetery Association are to be paid from the income on the aforesaid mentioned bank books, and the income from the bank books may be used for any purpose

connected with the monuments, curnings,  
grave markers or lots.

The income from these bank books  
need not necessarily all be used in the  
years that the interest may accrue, as  
sometime in the future there may be  
extra expenses in the care of the lots  
and the income may be used when  
and how the Trustees at any time  
may decide.
