Dear Sirs:

I am sending this date to Capt. Darius Weekes Secretary and Treasurer of the South Scarwich Cemetery, bank books of the Cape Cod Five Cents Savings Bank of Scarwich, Mass. No. 22422 and No. 22423 with deposits of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150. #) on each book, total three hundred dollars (\$300. #).

The income that accrues on bank book No. 22422 is to be used for the perpetual care of the burial lot in the South Scarwich Cemetery of Joseph P. and Almira Nickerson, and the income that accrues on bank book No. 22423 is to be used for the perpetual care of the burial lot in the South Scarwich Cemetery of James and Loretta Loveland.

The yearly assessments of the South Scarwich Cemetery Association are to be paid from the income on the aforesaid mentioned bank books, and the income from the bank books may be used for any purpose.

and the income may be used when
