The cemetery that surrounds the East Harwich United Methodist Church is known as the East Harwich Union Cemetery. It is located on the corner of Church Street and Queen Anne Road in East Harwich and the fence has fallen into disrepair. There are 24 granite posts that are broken or fractures and need to be replace and installed. This will require digging up the broken posts and removing them and installing new posts. In addition 46 rails that are either bent, rusted through or are missing that need to be replaced, there are 2 rails in-between each of the posts. This cemetery is at a very busy intersection in our Town and is one of the first impression that visitor gets when driving from Chatham into Harwich. Therefore the Cemetery Commission is hoping that the CPC will approve this application.

We currently have broken granite posts and corroded and broken pipes around the entire cemetery property. It is important that visitors have a positive experience when visiting.










Sections identified with Posts & Rails replacement.




Near the road many of the railsing are on the ground. Just for safety we need these replace so that children that attend programs are able to be stopped from running into the road when playing.

Chapter 114

CEMETERIES AND BURIALS

Section 18

CARE OF NEGLECTED BURIAL PLACES WITHIN LIMITS OF

TOWN

Section 18. Any town having within its limits an abandoned or neglected burying ground may take charge of the same and keep it in good order, and may appropriate money therefor, but no property rights shall be violated and no body shall be disinterred. No fence, tomb, monument or other structure shall be removed or destroyed, but the same may be repaired or restored.
