
Project Description: Installation of Flag Poles & Electricity at Veterans Memorial Circle in Evergreen Cemetery

Evergreen Cemetery contains 19 Acres and is flat and open. 7.28 acres is around the Veterans Memorial Circle.


Cemeteries have become open spaces for passive recreation. In Evergreen we have many people walking and enjoying this valuable greenspace.

As areas of East Harwich continues to grow its residents are looking for safe places to walk and enjoy their surroundings we would like to create an area of remembrance for our veterans.




Placement of Flags around the Gazebo
