SAND POND REVITILIZATION PROJECT PHASE 2

The Recreation and Youth Commission and Department is requesting funding in the amount of \$83,500 for Sand Pond Revitilization Phase 2 Project. This funding amount would cover materials, installation, prep work and contingencies for the proposed project.

Sand Pond is a Town of Harwich Public Beach located on Great Western Road in West Harwich. The public property occupies a significant amount of space and includes a beach area, boat house, restroom facility and large stone dust parking lot. Sand Pond was a staffed and lifeguarded Summer Town Beach up until 5 summers ago. At the time, we saw attendance numbers at Sand Pond dwindle and decided to move our summer staffing resources to another popular pond, Cahoons Pond Beach. While this was a very successful re-allocation of staffing, we still see a continuous need for improvements to the Sand Pond Beach in order to fully utilize it's seasonal potential. Therefore, last year, we submitted our request for the funding of Phase 1 of the Sand Pond project which included the construction and installation of a new pre-cast concrete restroom facility plus associated septic systems. Phase 1 was approved by the Community Preservation Committee for funding in the amount of \$125,000 and was, subsequently, approved at May 2019 Annual Town Meeting. Site engineering and septic system design has been completed for the project. The construction and installation of the new restroom facility will be completed by Summer Season 2021.

In order to continue our upgrade of the Sand Pond Town Beach Facility, we are requesting funding for Phase 2 of the project. This phase would include the following: new family picnic area, demolition and removal of current boathouse, new split rail fencing bordering parking lot and beach area, playground area with swing set, two children's spinner apparatus, and the legally required playground surfacing, prep/grading/landscaping and beautification for the effected area, and contingencies on the project as a whole. These additions and improvements will enhance the family beach atmosphere at the Sand Pond property.

The Harwich Highway Department will be contributing significant in-house labor to help complete multiple parts of this project. This save a significant amount of money in our request for funding.

In a future phase we will be looking to add a new lifeguard stand, a re-nourished beach area, a kayak rental area, and a storage shed for the property.

We feel that once all phases are complete, we can add new seasonal staff to lifeguard the beach. We also feel that we can potentially add gate attendants for entrance to the parking area during the summer months. The revenue from daily pass sales through gate attendants would easily compensate for the cost of new staffing.

We see Sand Pond, Harwich as an unpolished gem in town, that, with appropriate funding, management, and implementation can become a valuable pond beach asset to the town and it's citizens.

Harwich Highway Department will assist in the demolition and removal of current Sand Pond Boathouse for reduced cost. Department will also assist in removal of any scrub pine trees in path of Revitilization Project. All plans will be consulted with the Highway Department before implementation.

RECREATION AND YOUTH COMMISSION

Sand Pond Phase 2 Project and Community Preservation Committee Funding Application will be reviewed and approved by the Recreation and Youth Commission before October 30,2020 submittal.

COMMUNITY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE






