PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Cleaning, consolidation, repair and/or setting of grave markers.

- 1. 45 Monuments in need of repair, due to fractures or damage from falling over and /or previous failed repairs.
- 2. 158 Reset or New Foundations 108 headstones, 2 corner markers, 48 footstones either need to be reset or foundation repair. Monuments are leaning and are in need of treatment to be reset so that they will not topple over and to prevent future degradation.
- 3. New bases will be made where required.
- 4. 265 memorials will be cleaned and consolidated includes headstone and footstones.
- 5. Slate will not be consolidated but will be cleaned of biologicals.

- 6. Before and after digital photographs for each marker.
- 7. Supporting digital documentation.



East Harwich Union Cemetery earliest grave was from 1797 of Revolutionary War soldier Ebenezer Eldredge who died on 25 February 1797. Every grave tells a story of our town's past. It is our responsibility to preserve these burial places for future generations. This cemetery was opened after the old burial ground on Queen Anne Road was filled. It is located in the yard of the second Methodist Church in East Harwich and is known as the Harwich United Methodist Church (HUMC).

Earliest founding Town Members are important to the Town's heritage. This East Harwich Methodist Cemetery is a visual and cultural reminder of its past. Memorials throughout the burial grounds are in need of maintenance and restoration. The Overall goal is

preservation and stabilization to prevent future damage of this historic burying grounds. Caring for historic gravestones must be done by those trained in proper cleaning and preservation techniques. The Various types of stones (slate, marble, sandstone and limestone) each require a different technique for cleaning and removing of biological growths such as lichens. Often sealants are used to prevent the invasion of moisture.

Preservation the graves stones at East Harwich Union Cemetery is in the best interest of the Town. We have many people walking in the cemeteries visiting or doing genealogy, as this cemetery has Mayflower Descendants buried on the grounds. There is a need to make sure that the grounds are safe. Many of the stones are broken and face down and/or are unreadable due to biological growth covering the memorials. Many of the memorials are in pieces and will need to be reconstructed. This cemetery has a significate amount of historical monuments preserving them will ensure future generations can experience this historic burial ground. We owe it to our pioneering ancestors that their monuments are not forgotten and that their contributions will be remembered.

RE: Union Cemetery Gravestone Project

The Harwich Church congregation is concerned about the condition of the cemetery next to the church. We were disappointed that the town was not able to vote to refurbish the cemetery stones this year. Every year that funds are with held for repairs more valuable information is being lost to the weather. Currently many stones are almost impossible to read. A number of them, are cracked and loose and some could fall and cause injury. Some have been placed on the ground to avoid this from happening and the stones are now becoming buried and lost.

The cemetery grave sights host many sea captains, a Revolution Veteran, a Civil War Private that served in Company A, 58th Regiment, Massachusetts, Volunteers and died in the Battle of the Wilderness.

The members of the church understand that the cemetery is not town property. But have been informed that at the 1949 Town Meeting, Article 60: To see if the Town will vote to accept Chapter 227 of the Acts of General Courts for 1948, as amended certain cemetery associations in the Town of Harwich, and to act fully thereon, "Hereafter to hold and maintain, but for cemetery purposes only." It was moved by Oscar J. Cahoon, and duly seconded that: The Town vote to accept the provision of Chapter 227 of the Acts of the General Courts of 1948, This motion was carried without opposition. Which in sort turned over to the Town of Harwich all the maintenances of the cemeteries in town. After passage the town has been maintaining this cemetery to the present. To the church this means that the Town of Harwich already has the right to come onto our property mow, maintain, refurbish the gravestones and whatever else is needed to be done to keep the cemetery safe and clean. To clear up any doubts this letter is from the same members giving the Harwich Cemetery Commission and or Robbin Kelley the right to contact a business that has the proper knowledge and experience in restoring cemetery gravestones to do so.

This is also to let you know that even though this has been a closed cemetery for burials that we still get visitors, some even leave flowers and put flags on veterans, gravestones. Please reconsider the importance of this project and that the longer it is delayed the more it will cost the town in the future. Please vote in favor of preserving these historical memorial stones.

General Court Chapter 277 Acts of 1948

Chap. 277 An Act authorizing the town of harwich to receive AND ADMINISTER THE PROPERTY OF CERTAIN CEMETERY ASSOCIATIONS IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1. Each of the following-named cemetery associations, situated in the town of Harwich, to wit: Baptist Cemetery, Smith Cemetery, Chase Cemetery, North Har-

with Cemetery, Kelley Cemetery, Centre Cemetery, Harding Cemetery, Seth Eldridge Cemetery, Old Methodist Cemetery, End of the Pond Cemetery and South Harvieh Cemetery, or any of then, hereinafter called associations, may, by deed duly executed, convey and transfer to said town, and said town is lereby authorized and empowered to receive, and thereafter to hold and maintain, but for cemetery purposes only, and subject to all rights heretofore existing in any burial lots, the real and personal property of the associations and the said of the transfer of the trust funds as hereinafter provided, the associations shall be dissolved; and the cemeteries of the ussociations shall be and become public burial places, grounds or

for other purposes, and also any property devised or bequeathed to the associations under the will of any person living at the time of said transfer or conveyance or under the will of any deceased person not then probated. Interest and dividends accruing on funds deposited in trust with any savings bank under authority of section thirty-seven or section thirty-eight of chapter one hundred and sixty-eight of the associations a conveyance and transfer of, and administer, all funds or other property held by the associations in trust for the perpetual care of the lots in the cometeries and the General Laws, or with any other banking institution, for the benefit of the associations, or of any lots in the cemeteries, may, after such conveyance, be paid by such bank or institu-Secrion 2. In so far as authorized by a decree of a court of competent jurisdiction and in compliance with the terms tion to the treasurer of said town; and upon such payment said treasurer shall use the same for the purposes of said and conditions of such decree, said town may receive from

Secrox 3. All real and personal property and property rights, acquired by said town from the associations under authority of this act, shall be held and managed by said town in the same manner in which cities and towns are authorized by law to hold and manage property for cemetery purposes; provided, that all rights which any persons have acquired in the cemeteries of the associations or any lots therein shall remain in force to the same extent as if this act

had not been passed and such transfer had not occurred. The records of the associations shall be delivered to the clerk of said town and such clerk may certify copies thereof. Secrons 4. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance by a majority of the registered voters of the town of Harwich voting thereon at a regular or special town meeting held in the current year, but not otherwise.

The commission will need to get updated price quotes, as soon as we have new totals we will update the Board.




