## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The Harwich Recreation Department and Commission is requesting funding in the amount of \$110,000 for the re-surfacing of the current tennis and pickle ball courts at Brooks Park, Harwich.

This project would include the crack repair, sealant, re-surfacing and re-lining of all the current tennis courts and pickle ball courts at Brooks Park.

The Brooks Park Complex has been a vital recreational hub for the Town of Harwich over the past several years. The Recreation Department and Commission has done extensive work on the area to upgrade the existing resources as well as add new amenities for the public.

The Brooks Tennis Courts are very heavily used by open tennis play, the Monomoy High School Tennis Team and the Harwich Recreation seasonal programs.

The Pickle Ball Courts are also heavily used and always growing as pickle ball increases in popularity for all ages. We have seen court use from the seniors to the youth. This past spring/summer pickle ball season we had over 400 registrants for the program.

Part of offering these recreational programs to the community is the ability to maintain our great facilities and keep them playable and safe for all users, young and old.

As expected on Cape Cod, we see a very varied climate and temperature differential throughout the year here on the Cape and this does have an effect on surfaces like those seen at the Brooks Tennis and Pickle Ball courts. With this environmental inevitability comes cracks in the courts in addition to the normal wear and tear from its constant use. This has led to the end of the useful life of the current court surface and requires renovation.

This project will enable us to keep the courts playable and safe and ensure that the citizens of Harwich have great recreational facilities to promote the continued health, movement and general well-being of the community as a whole.
