The Recreation and Youth Commission and Department are requesting funding in the amount of \$37,000 from the Community Preservation Committee to replace the electrical system at Veterans Memorial Field Complex behind Harwich Community Center

This request would include funding for the complete replacement of the electrical system that controls the irrigation for the multi-field complex. The Harwich Highway Department and their representatives recommended this article. The field irrigation system will be rendered unusable without this improvement to the electrical system. The Recreation Department has worked with the Harwich Highway Department to determine the needs for this project and what is best for the field complex going forward.

The Veterans Memorial Field Complex consists of Bassett Softball Field and Crowell Baseball Field and the open recreational space between them. This facility was constructed 15 years ago with CPC funding and has seen abundant use during the busy spring and summer seasons. We have had many bookings including senior softball, Monomoy softball, J.V. Monomoy baseball, AAU Baseball, baseball clubs of Cape Cod, the Cranberry Festival, the Cape Cod Commercial Fisherman's Alliance Annual Hookers Ball, rugby tournaments, lacrosse tournaments and much more.

We feel that it is imperative that we continue to maintain these fields for the use of citizens and seasonal bookers alike. The current electrical system is at the end of its useful life and will no longer be able to sustain the current irrigation system for the fields. We feel that this is necessary to sustain the pristine facilities we currently have in the Town of Harwich.

Community Center Fields

The electrical wiring is failing on the community center fields. The wiring seems to have reached the end of its useful life causing a host of issues for the last 3 years. Also contributing to the issues have been 2 lightning strikes. We have been piecing it together over the last 3 yrs and especially this past yr. I am suggesting that we shut down the system until the electrical system is updated to preserve the well and all the existing piping. I am very concerned of something failing when we are not around causing the well to overheat and crack the piping due to excessive heat and the pressure of constant running (and this will happen eventually). This would cause a complete failure and cost well over 15k+ to repair if this came to pass, and would cause more problems for months with sediment then getting in the lines.

Understand that not running the irrigation system next yr is a last resort for us. For if we did have a major break, we could possibly have to shut the field down for an extended time to do the needed repairs.

The repairs would add decoders (which act like a surge protector) to the electrical system which will help prevent this happing again in the future, although when your dealing with a lot of gigawatts, from lighting, nothing is guaranteed. Whitehouse has these and the irrigation system was fine, even though the tower that got struck blew out the tower and caused electrical problems in the neighboring buildings. (Those towers have grounded lighting rodes on them)

In summary, the irrigation system has reached its end of life and WILL NOT run again until these repairs are made, whether it this year or in 5 years. I would get this done now before prices go up even more.
