PROJECT TITLE: Harwich Oak Street Bikeways Crossing Lights
PROJECT AMOUNT REQUESTED: \$13,000
PROJECT DESCRIPTION: To install a motion senser and button acuated solar powered system which will alert motor vehicle traffic that a bicyclist or pedestrain is approaching the intersection at Oak Street on the Old Colony Rail Trail. This crossing will require two beacons one on each side of the crossing. The use of a solar pann eleliminates the use of electricity. These crossing lights are of a very similar design/function as the recently placed CPC approved crossing lights at the Headwaters Drive Cape Cod Rail Trail junction.
