Article IV To see what method the Directors will take for the care of the Cemetery for the year 1949

Article V - To see if the members present will vote to accept the deed of land adjoining the cemetery on the west, given by Miss Sheba E. Berry to the Cemetery Corp. and to act fully thereon.

Article VI To transact any other business that may legally come before the meeting.

Under Article I Mr. Chas. J. Chase was chosen for moderator.

Under Article II The report of the clerk was read by Mr. Chase and Miss Annie Chase gave a clear report

in the office of treasurer.
 Under Article III Miss Annie Chase was elected Treasurer Mr Robert Chase as auditor.

 Mr Charles S. Chase, who has served the Cemetery Corporation faithfully for many years, asked to be relieved of some of his duties and Harold Wilson was elected clerk to help him carry out his duties. A vote of appreciation was given to Mr Chase for his years of service.

Under Article II the Directors pledged to do all they could towards the upkeep of the Cemetery with the small amount of money available.

Under Article V It was voted to accept the deed of the land given by Miss Shuba E. Berry, and it was voted to send a letter of appreciation from the members of the Corporation

Art. 2. To hear report of Clerk and Treasurer for year ending Mar. 31, '50. The reports were read and accepted. They were audited by Mr. Chas. S. Chase as the Auditor. Mr. Robt. Chase was out of town.

Art. 3 To elect a Clerk, Treasurer, three Directors and one Auditor to serve the ensuing year.

Harold Wilson was elected clerk. Miss Annie Chase Treasurer, Robert Chase Auditor, and Chas. S. Chase, Walter W. Kelley and Harold Wilson as Directors. All officers of the Corporation having served the previous year.

Art. 4. To see what method the Directors will take in the care and upkeep of the Cemetery.

Mr. Chas Chase was to see the Septoy Highway about cleaning the front of cemetery. The tool building has been given a coat of paint and minor repairs have been done.
