



Constitution

- Art 1 This Association shall be called the Pine Grove Cemetery Association of West Warwick.
- Art 2 The object of this Association shall be to purchase and permanently enclose and otherwise improve two and one half acres of land ~~partly~~ owned by Amos Smith, for burial purposes.
- Art 3 The officers of this Association shall consist of a President, Secretary and Treasurer and a Committee of three persons, who together shall constitute a board of directors, which officers shall be chosen by ballot annually ^{during the first week of February} ~~on the month of February~~ each year and shall serve until others are chosen.
- Art 4 It shall be the duty of the President to preside at the meetings of the Association, of the Secretary to call such meetings and keep a true record of all the proceedings. Also to keep a catalogue of the names of the members, and issue certificates of membership with the President of the Treasurer to receive all monies and pay out the same as the directors may order, to keep ~~and~~ account thereof and report at the Annual Meeting of the Association.
- 5th It shall be the duty of the directors to have the general management of the business of the Association and shall superintend the laying out and fencing the Cemetery grounds.

Art 6th Any person may become a member
of this Association by purchasing
a lot in said Cemetery and shall
be entitled to vote on all matters
affecting the interest of the Association
Each proprietor entitled to one vote

By Laws

- Art-1 The Directors shall appoint some person to have the general care of the Cemetery after the grounds are laid out and fenced - to act in the capacity of Superintendent and shall keep an account of all the interments in said Cemetery
- Art-2 As soon as the Funds of the Association will admit the Trustees shall cause to be built in some suitable place in the yard, a Tomb which shall be owned by the Proprietors and for their use
- Art-3 The Proprietors have the right to erect on their lots fences, monuments and stones of appropriate character subject to the approval of the Directors
- Art-4 The price of each lot in said Cemetery shall be Eight dollars for 340 square feet and the Proprietors shall have the right of choice at Auction, after due notice having been given - Proprietors paying the above sum not subject to further amount
- Art-5 This Constitution and By Laws may be altered or amended at any Annual Meeting of this Association
- Art-6 Each Proprietor after receiving his or her Certificate of lot in said Cemetery, shall within twelve months clear & improve the same satisfactory to the board of Directors or forfeit them to this Association



By Laws

By Laws of Pine Grove Cemetery, West Warwick,
Incorporated Feb. 13, 1903.

Name

art. 1. This organization shall be known as the Pine Grove Cemetery Incorporation of West Warwick.

art. 2. The Officers of this organization shall consist of Three Directors, Clerk, Treasurer, and Superintendent, to be elected annually by ballot, and to serve, until others are elected and qualified.

art. 3. Whenever vacancy exists in any office from resignation, death, or any other cause, it shall be the duty of the Directors of this organization to fill such vacancy for the remainder of the year.

art. 4. It is expected that each proprietor will have suitable care of his own lot, and said lot shall not be used for any purpose other than a burial place for the dead, and the erection of monuments, Tablets, Slabs, Curbing, Fencing etc. within its limits, and nothing which the general public would consider unsightly or offensive to good taste shall be allowed to remain on said lots as permanent, but in a reasonable time in the judgment of the Directors it shall be removed.

art. 5.

Directors' Duties.

The Directors stand behind the Supt. who may appeal to them when needed in any matter, The expenditure of all moneys necessary for actual charges, improvements, repairs, etc. out of the treasury of said organization shall be with the approval of the Directors.

art. 6. If any tree or shrub by its roots or branches becomes detrimental to the adjacent lots or avenues, it shall be the duty of the Directors to cause such tree or shrub or such parts thereof as are detrimental to be removed.

art. 7. When any enlargement of said grounds is required, the Directors shall constitute a committee to attend to the same and their doings shall be ratified at a meeting of the proprietors of said cemetery.

By Laws (continued)

Duties of the Clerk.

art. 8. It shall be the duty of the clerk to keep a just and true record of the doings of the organization in a book kept for that purpose. He shall receive all moneys from whatever source, pay the same over to the Treasurer and take a receipt thereof.

art. 9. He shall also record all burials and removals to and from the cemetery as reported to him through the sexton, stating name, age, date and place of death, date of burial, and No. of lot, and make any other record, pertinent to the case.

art. 10. All meetings shall be called by the clerk, by posting the notice or call in West Norwich Post office seven days previous to the holding of such meeting.

Meetings shall be held annually on the last Saturday of March at such place as the clerk may provide and seven Proprietors shall constitute a quorum.

In case of the absence of the clerk, the chairman of the Board of Directors shall call such meeting in the same manner.

art. 11. Special meetings may be called on request made in writing to the clerk by a majority of the Directors or ten members of the organization, which request shall state the object of the meeting.

art. 12. When an article to be inserted in the call for a meeting is presented to the clerk with the names of three or more Proprietors, it shall be his duty to insert the same.

Duties of the Treasurer.

art. 13. The Treasurer shall receive all moneys from the clerk, giving his receipt for the same, and keep a true record of the same in a book for that purpose, and shall report his doings at the annual meeting in each year.

art. 14. All bills paid by the Treasurer against the corporation must be approved by the Directors.

By-Laws - (continued)

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art 15. All surplus money in the hands of the Treasurer over fifteen dollars, if such surplus shall amount to five dollars, shall be deposited in the Capital Five Cent Savings Bank in the name of the Pine Grove Cemetery Incorporation unless otherwise ordered by the Directors.

art 16. Supt. Duties.

It shall be the duty of the Superintendent to keep in proper repair the fences, and have the same painted when needed; also take care of the avenues, and passages between the lots, grading when required, he may also be appointed to have perpetual care of any lots when desired by the owners of such lots, or those who have the care of them, when sums of money have been appropriated for that purpose.

The Supt. also shall have the care of such public lots as may be set apart by the Directors which are useful in the care of the burial of the dead, who own no lots; people who are poor and destitute.




The Supt. also may be applied to to procure a sexton for the digging and backing of graves and the depositing of the dead in them, completing the same to be left in a proper manner and also any other duties which seem to belong to his position, and all with the approval of the Directors, and said Superintendent may have suitable compensation for his services, approved by a majority of the Directors.


art 17. Notes taken in payment for lots, shall be with interest and with good and sufficient security.


art 18. Certificates for lots sold shall be signed by the Chairman of the Board of Directors and by the clerk.


By Laws (continued)

- art. 19. No lot will be considered sold until fully paid for, and if parties make retirement before paying in full; the Directors reserve the right to remove the bid to the free and public lots and sell such lot to other parties.
- art. 20. Prior to the adjournment of any meeting of this organization, the records of such meeting shall be read and approved.
- art. 21. The Directors may receive sums of money not less than Fifty Dollars to be invested and the income of which to be applied for the perpetual care of lots in said cemetery. The Corporation shall give the proprietors of said lots an agreement binding the Corporation to spend the income in the repair, improvement, and preservation of such lots and the erections thereon forever.
- art. 22. All moneys or funds entrusted to the Corporation for the care of lots shall be in charge of the Treasurer and he shall invest the same under the directions of the Directors in Savings Banks, or in such securities as are authorized by the laws of the State of Massachusetts, relating to the investment of Savings Banks.
- art. 23. The Treasurer shall keep a record of the funds entrusted to the Corporation for the care and maintenance of individual lots and a statement of this record shall be exhibited at every annual meeting.
- art. 24. These By Laws may be altered or amended at any annual meeting by a vote of two-thirds of the Proprietors present. Notice of such amendments having been given in the call for the meeting.
- art. 25. To have the ownership of a lot always known, it is quite proper for every Proprietor to designate the future ownership of his or her lots, and have it recorded on the certificate of such lots, and also with the clerk of the Cemetery; but if such record has been omitted and the lot falls to a number of heirs, the oldest shall be entitled to the casting or business vote, unless some one is appointed of which there are several.
