## EXTRACT FROM THE BY-LAWS. <br> - DIVIDENDS.

On the second Wednesday of Apprize and of October in each year there may be declared and paid a dividend of at least ONE AND ${ }^{\circ}$ a half PER $_{0}^{\circ}$ Centum per annul on all sums from one dollar to one thousand dollars which shall have been deposited for the spate of six months next preceding said Wednesday, and a proportionate fate of interest shall be paid on sums which shall have been deposited for the space of three months But on fractional parts of a dollar no dividend shall be allowed. Dividends not withdrawn wii be added to and draw interest as an original deposit, until the amount is increased to sixteen hundred dollars. 000
All interest, if the same be not called for, shall be added to the principal of the Depositor, and shall be entitled to interest as much as an original deposit; but in case money is withdrawn before the declaration of a dividend, no interest shall be allowed on it for the period which may have elapsed since the last divident was declared.
Depositors may receive their dividends either personally, or by a written order, or by letter of attorney, on production of the Book of Deposit.


DRAFTS.

Money deposited shall only be drawn out by the Depositor, or some person by him legally authosivole abut no person shall receive any part of his oribcipal of interest without producing the original book, that stoic payment. may be entered. therein. No money can be withdrawn except on the third Wednesday of January, April, July and Cetober; provided, however, ${ }^{\bullet}$ that the Treasurer may pay any $\dot{9}{ }^{\circ}{ }^{\circ}$ sitar, who applies on an other day, his interest or principal, of part thereof, © the money $n_{6}$ hand be sufficient for the purpose week's. notice before the day of withdrawing having bean given to he treasurer.). All moneys received by the Treasuresbll be either specie or bills taken in deposit by the Boston dank:
Upon the death of any depositor ${ }^{2}$ en nay standing to his credit shall be paid to his legatee, or lir at law, or legal representative, conformably to the lathe State; and if the sum shall be under fifty dollars these may be paid to the legatee, or next of kin, or legal representative, without the expense of any probate of will, or letter of administration; and it is agreed that such payment shall discharge the Corporation.

As the officers of this Institution may be unable to identify every Depositor transacting business at the Bank, the Institution will not be responsible for loss sustained where the Depositor has not given notice of his book being stolen or lost, if such book be paid in whole or in part on presentment.
