RECREATION AND MAINTENANCE MATTERS:

♦ Approval of Minutes from 1/21/21

A motion was made by Michael Hurley to approve the minutes of 1/21/21 as written; Vahan Khachadoorian seconded the motion. Vote is unanimous, 4 in favor.

Director's Report- Commission Meeting- 2-16-21

- ♦ CPC Articles At a meeting of the Community Preservation Committee, the Committee approved all of our three articles for funding including: Brooks Park Lighting, Senior Memorial Fencing, and Sand Pond Restoration. These articles will be voted at the May Town Meeting.
- ♦ Whitehouse Field Scoreboard things are moving ahead with the scoreboard project. The Selectmen will soon vote to approve the donation from the Harwich Mariners for the lighting as well as the scoreboard. Design renderings of the scoreboard will be presented at this Commission meeting for final approval.
- ♦ Whitehouse Field Lighting Selectmen approved the purchase of the materials for the lighting project at Whitehouse Field at their last meeting. These will be purchased by town administration and town engineer with the hope of installation for this coming season.
- **Spring Programming -** while we are still under corona restrictions, we are currently putting together a brochure for the spring to include continued after school child care as well as some outdoor programming such as T-ball, flag football, basketball etc.
- ♦ **Summer 2021 -** We are working on a brochure for the summer season which will include a scaled back version of our normal summer camp, outdoor basketball, outdoor summer ball, and modified tennis lessons. We will soon be sending out our invites to returning summer employees in preparation for the summer season.
- ◆ FY2022 Budget The Town Administrator distributed his budget and budget message to department heads and our budget is going forward as we submitted it for \$532,864. This is a 0.6% decrease from last year and meets the budget message requiring level funded budget or lower.
- ◆ Town Administration Joe Powers and the Selectmen have approved the appointing of the new Assistant Town Administrator, Meggan Eldredge. Meggan has been the Health Director and she will take on the new role.

 - ❖ John reported to members he submitted and attended the Recreation annual report to the Board of Selectman last week and it went very well.

 - ❖ David Nixon told Commission members the total amount in project articles this year that were funded was \$2,577,449.00.

♦ Whitehouse Field scoreboard design vote. After discussion by all members present the following motion was made.

A motion was made by Vahan Khachadoorian to approve the Whitehouse Field scoreboard design as presented by the Mariners through the Harwich Athletic Association; David Nixon seconded the motion. Vote is unanimous, 4 in favor.

- ◆ Eric Beebe Brooks Park incomplete restroom project has been denied a variance from state ADA and he is meeting with Megan and Joe to come up with a plan to proceed forward.
- ◆ David Nixon The Brooks Park Lighting article is on hold until the extra funding needed is approved at this year's Town Meeting.
- David Nixon Asked if anyone knew if Megan Eldredge has a procurement certification.

- ♦ Whitehouse Field Lighting Project There will be a bid opening for the lighting project based on the RFP issued by Town Administration on Thursday March 18th. The project seems to be moving forward. I will update the commission at our meeting on the bid opening results.
- ♦ Whitehouse Field Scoreboard Project A contract has been issued for the procurement of a new scoreboard for Whitehouse Field. Part of the funding for this project, as well as, the lighting project will be paid for by the \$75,000 donation from the Harwich Mariners.
- ♦ Sand Pond Restroom I am currently putting together a draft RFP for the Sand Pond Restroom project to submit to Town Administration for their review.
- ♦ **FY2022 Budget Hearing** I had a budget hearing with the Board of Selectmen and the Finance Committee on March 12 where I reviewed our FY22 budget. There were very few questions and the boards seemed happy with our submittal.
- ◆ Finance Committee Project Meeting I presented this year's three CPC projects that will be on the warrant for the May Town Meeting to the Finance Committee for their approval/recommendation on March 11. The Finance Committee voted to approve all 3 of our projects unanimously.
- ♦ **Spring Programs** We will be running a slate of outdoor spring programs that will begin in April and we are already starting to see very good registration numbers. We will be offering:

After School Child Care Program Youth Flag Football Hoops with Noop Basketball Clinic Tball Clinic Travel League Softball

- ♦ Summer 2021 Programs We are working on our summer brochure for 2021 and we are happy to have a semblance of programming back this summer. We will be offering a scaled back version of our normal summer full day program, summer ball programs, and tennis lessons. We do not plan to offer swim lessons because social distancing and mask wearing are not possible in this type of program.
- ♦ Summer Beaches 2021 We have emailed out our invites to returning staff for this upcoming beach season. We are planning on having a full beach staff and also hope to re-open the full parking lot at Pleasant Road Beach and resume selling daily passes there this summer which will significantly increase daily pass revenue for the Town. I am in consultation with the Health Department regarding beach corona monitors and early response looks like we will have some corona monitors but not to the extent that we did last summer.
