Thank you for submitting an application for the 2022 Grant Round of the Massachusetts Dredging Program. This year, the Executive Office of Housing and Economic Development (EOHED) received over \$3.2 million in requests to support dredging in the Commonwealth. Applications were thoroughly reviewed by EOHED in collaboration with staff at the Massachusetts Office of Coastal Zone Management (CZM) and the Seaport Economic Council.

On behalf of the Baker-Polito Administration, I am pleased to inform you that a grant in the amount of \$48,000 has been approved for the Town of Harwich (Grantee). We are excited to support the Allen Harbor Dredging Project FY23. You will be contacted by a program staff member to discuss any conditions and/or specific requirements related to this grant award as well as next steps for contracting.

Please be advised that this letter does not constitute an agreement or contract with EOHED or the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, nor does it confer any rights onto the Grantee. The specified grant commitment is contingent upon the successful execution of a contract between EOHED and the Grantee by December 31, 2022. Projects not under contract by this date may be required to reapply in the following grant round. Further, the Grantee is not authorized to proceed with any purchases or construction work, for which it expects reimbursement from this grant, until such contract has been fully executed.
