### **OLD UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

#### A. Water Rates

## B. Water Commission's Authority over Department Staff

The Board discussed past history of overseeing Water Department employees before the change was made to the Town Administrator overseeing Water Department employees.

Because the Water Department's budget includes Water Department employee salaries, the Board would like to play a larger role and discussed having authority over Water Department employees once again.

Chair Carreiro recommended that Superintendent Pelletier schedule a meeting with the Interim Town Administrator to open up the discussion. Clerk Thompson advised also to converse with the Town Administrator about sewer employees as well.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

#### A. Wastewater

The Board of Water Commissioners were just recently sworn in as Water/Wastewater Commissioners. Superintendent Pelletier briefly updated the Board on the topic of Wastewater. The topic of Wastewater will remain on the agenda going forward.

## B. Nexamp Solar

Superintendent Pelletier informed the Board that the Water Department should be anticipating its first check from the Nexamp solar field this September.

### C. DWSP Grant

Superintendent Pelletier spoke with the Office of Environmental and Energy Affairs about the Drinking Water Supply Protection Grant and they anticipate their next grant cycle being distributed early this winter. The Board now has indication of the timeline.

## SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Pelletier updated the Board on pumping volumes and drought status. The Water Department is on track for a record high year. Although there is a drought, the groundwater levels are still extremely healthy.
