Discussion re: extensions for those who have not submitted their request for reimbursement. Also, discussion of policy re: unreturned paperwork and status of projects. Sharon confirmed that the MCC date of confirmation to accepted 2023 grantees was 1/29/2023. Therefore, the deadline for extension requests or requests for payment of completed projects is 1/29/2024.

**Old Business**- There were 36 submitted applications for 2024 grants. Reviewed the tentative approvals made at November Board meeting and, after further discussion, made some changes and unanimously approved 23 applications for full or partial funding.
