As discussed and requested I have attempted to summarize a timeline of events that occurred over the years for the Library preservation project:

- October 2011 the trustees discussed the restoration as a potential project to the CPC
- January 2012 CPC approves \$0 funds for the project
- November 2012 Discussion of funding a study to determine what needs to be done and the root causes. No action taken.
- September 2013 Requested for CPC to fund the study CPC passes
- May 1014 Town meeting.
- December 2014 Contract awarded to Mcginley Kalsow.
- August 2015 Assessment complete and results presented
- **December 2015** Capital Outlay supports and CPC Votes not to. After meeting with HDHC, The trustees returned to CPC and received approval for \$540,000.00
- May 2016 and approved in May Town meeting
- September 2016 Selectmen sign contract for architectural support for \$49,892.00 leaving \$490,108.00 for the restoration project
- April 2017 GC Bids received ranging from \$642.5k \$776k. Decision was made to go out again with alternates resulting a single bidder with all alternates totaling over \$1m
- September 2017- Request submitted to CPC for \$300k. Estimate was based on the actual bids received in April and June of 2017. Presented to CPC in November
