At the present time the course had made huge strides in turf recover, so far the following has been done.

- Fairways aerated and over seeded in August, applied starter fertilizer
- Started fairways again and re-seeded again,

- Tee's have been aerated and over seeded in September and starter fertilizer
- Greens aerated and over seeded in October, top dressed and fertilized
- Driving range tee has been aerated and top dressed and fertilized, grass tee is closed for the season
- Fall projects have gone to bid, will be open and awarded by end of October to start work November 1 hopefully
- Tree work to start in November as well
- Stump grinding will also be done in December as time allows
- Wrapping up 2016 maintenance season prep for winter
- Blowing out irrigation, vert-cut greens and top-dressing again, spraying greens for snow mold, prepping for budget season
