July 2017	In order to meet Seller's closing requirement of July 2017 as well as give HCT time to seek Town, State, and private funds, HCT has The Compact of Cape Cod Conservation Trusts buy-and-hold the property until June 2019.
May 2018	Harwich Town Meeting voters unanimously approve \$200,000 toward the project in exchange for a permanent conservation restriction.
June 2018	Harwich Conservation Commission votes its commitment to accept a permanent conservation restriction on the property.
July 2018	HCT submits Conservation Partnership grant application to the State.
