HH2024-03: George Stearns, owner, through their agent John Eldredge, has filed for a Certificate of Non-Applicability. The project proposes alterations to replace windows and siding. The structure is over 100 years old according to State and Town Assessing records and is located at **706 Main Street Map: 41 Parcel: B3**

HH2024-04: Stanley Bowden, trustee of Bowden Rufus S. Tr., owner, has filed for a Notice of Intent. The project proposes a full demolition for the detached garage. The structure is over 100 years old according to Town Assessing records and is located at **188 Bank Street Map: 23 Parcel: B1-A**

HH2024-05: Miguel Esteves, owner, through their agent Dana Greene, has filed for a Notice of Intent. The project proposes a partial demolition to replace windows and siding. The structure is over 100 years old according to Town Assessing records and is located at **1626 Orleans Rd. Map: 107 Parcel: E8-1**
