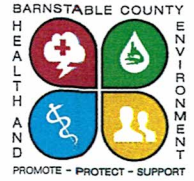

- State-supplied vaccines available at no cost to uninsured adults
- Federal Vaccine for Children (VFC) Program provides immunizations at no cost to children 18 and under who have no insurance, MassHealth, or Medicaid
