Instructions for Completing this Application

- 1. **Voter Information** Provide your name, the address where you are registered to vote, your ballot mailing address (if different) and date of birth.
- 2. **Ballot Information** If you are applying for a Vote by Mail ballot for a primary and are not registered in the Democratic, Libertarian or Republican parties, be sure to choose a ballot. If you are registered in the Democratic, Libertarian or Republican parties, you can only receive that Party's ballot. If you are not enrolled in one of the three named parties and you do not select a ballot type, a ballot will <u>not</u> be sent to you for the indicated Primary.
- 3. **Assistance** If you are helping someone complete this application, or if you are requesting a ballot for a family member, fill out this section.
- 4. Sign your name If you cannot sign your name, you may ask someone to sign your name in your presence.

Submitting the Application

This completed application can be returned to the Harwich Town Clerk's Office by mail, in person at the counter or via secure drop box, or by email (applications returned by email must include a visible hand-written signature; typed signatures cannot be accepted).

If you have already returned a Vote by Mail application or postcard to get a Vote by Mail ballot from the Town of Harwich for all elections in 2024, you do not need to return this application again.

Notes about Vote by Mail Applications:

- In the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Vote by Mail applications are only good for the calendar year in which they are received.
- If you have already returned a Vote by Mail application or postcard to get a Vote by Mail ballot from the Town of Harwich for all elections in 2024, you do *not* need to return this application again.
- If you are moving from another community, applications do <u>not</u> travel with you to your new community – you will need to re-apply in your new community if you wish to receive a Vote by Mail ballot. Please return this paper application in order to receive your mailed ballot from the Town of Harwich.
- Vote By Mail ballots for the State Primary:
 - o If you are enrolled in the Democratic, Libertarian or Republican parties, you will receive that party-specific ballot automatically. If you are registered as UNENROLLED or in a political designation, you *must* select which party's ballot you wish to receive (Democratic, Libertarian, or Republican), or a Primary ballot will **not** be sent to you.
- Under state law, Towns may opt out of offering Vote by Mail for local elections. This decision is made
 by the Select Board and must be determined on an election by election basis. The Select Board will
 make this decision no later than 45 days before the election. If the Town opts out of Vote by Mail for
 a local election, voters who meet qualifying criteria may vote Absentee (see below).

Absentee Voting is Always an Option for All Elections

To qualify as an Absentee Voter, you **must** be either unable to vote at the polls on Election Day due to absence from Town on Election Day, have a religious belief that prevents you from voting at your polling location, or have a disability that prevents you from voting at your polling location. In-Person Early Voting <u>will</u> be available – details to come Vote by Mail will be available, application must be **received** by October 29, 2024 @ 5 PM
