**Get to Know the Roses: Tupelo Honey** 

It's July 6, steamy and hot in the garden. Tupelo Honey is in full bloom with thick dark green leaves surrounding lemon chiffon-colored roses. English Lavender, Stokesia and pale lavender tall Phlox complete the picture making the garden a dreamy and calming place.

Tupelo Honey is a 4-5 foot Kordes Sunbelt, zone 5, self cleaning, fragrant rose that was alive to the tips of the canes after our zero degree day last winter.

Town of Harwich – Hall of Fame
Charles D. Cahoon
(1861 – 1951)
Inducted May 2010

Charles D. Cahoon was born on Parallel Street in Harwich Center. He was a prolific painter who became known for carefully detailed, peaceful landscapes and seascapes of Cape Cod views. It is thought that he created over 2,500 paintings, many of which were gifts to family and friends. It is believed that Charles Cahoon taught himself to draw when he was a cabin boy on his father's fishing vessel, using his spare time to sketch and paint.

Leaving the sea as a young man, he spent a few years learning the photography

business at his uncle's studio on Main Street in Harwich Center. He moved from Boston and worked for twenty years as a re-toucher in a photography studio. Around age 40, he decided to devote himself to painting, dividing his time between Cape Cod and the city. Finally, he decided to live only in Harwich—he became the "village artist." Charles Cahoon was recognized as the Cape's first master painter and his work is considered by many in the art world to be greatly under-appreciated.

Pebbles has since slithered along on the property. Try and **Community Center.** 











Due to an unprecedented demand for passports, current processing times are exceptionally long. As of July 2023, the U.S. State Department has been receiving about 400,000 applications per week, so before you start planning your trip (or if you already have a trip coming up), make sure your passport is up-to-date!
