Get to Know the Roses - Peace and Love and Peace

Ping Lim, a rose breeder at Bailey Nurseries, crossed an unnamed seedling with *Peace* and came up with *Love and Peace*, an award winning rose. The object was to produce a more disease free plant, and it is, but the subtle, soft and dreamy beauty of *Peace* is gone. *Love & Peace* produces many 5 ½ inch, high centered, yellow blooms edged with strawberry red. It is an impressive rose that always attracts attention and is usually in bloom. Look for it next to the sidewalk on the south side of the Community center behind the COA.

Next month we will compare *Love and Peace* to *Delightful Phyllis*, an exquisite rose bred by retired Texas Banker Ray Ponton, which is as obscure as *Peace* is famous.



- 1. Complete the Citizen's Committee Vacancy Form found on the VIC website
- 2. Meet with Selectmen Interview Committee to discuss your application, including your interests and qualifications. If the Interview Committee decides to forward your application to the full Board of Selectmen, it will be the subject of a vote.
- 3. Upon appointment by the Board of Selectmen, the applicant will be notified in writing by the Town Administrator's office of their appointment to the Board or Committee and the term of the appointment. You will receive a copy of the Town of Harwich Committee Handbook and be required to undergo Ethics Training offered by the Secretary of State's Office, and must be sworn in by the Town Clerk before taking any action at a meeting of the Board or Committee.

The Harwich Voter Information Committee works to inform and prepare town voters on issues to be addressed at Annual/Special Town Meetings and local elections, and to encourage voter registration and participation.

VIC activities include Channel 18 televised panel discussions on the Town Warrant, the Town's financial status, and other issues affecting residents, as well as a Meet the Candidates forum. VIC also produces and disseminates educational materials to inform local voters on election events, meetings, or other guidance on participating in local government.

The charge of the Voter Information Committee is to offer education to Harwich voters, and as such focuses only on local issues and elections. The Harwich Voter Information Committee is a purely non-partisan town committee.

Residents are encouraged to apply by submitting the Citizens Activity Record Form to the Board of Selectmen
