Dear Members of the Board:

We request relief from parking restrictions which prohibit parking of our family cars adjacent to our cottage at 1 Ocean Avenue in Harwich Port.

Since 1963 we have parked against our fence on Ocean Avenue south of Atlantic Street with objection from no one until the erection of highway department signs two years ago. In no way do we obstruct access to the Ocean Avenue landing or beach.

1 Ocean Avenue is a 40' x 80' lot, unique in that the building occupies the land without provision for vehicle storage. Neighbors have off-street parking on their premises.

We, therefore, request that the Board recognize the hardship created by the recently invoked parking restrictions, have the signs removed, thereby permitting us to continue a nearly thirty year tradition of parking adjacent to our cottage.

Further, we request that this matter be placed on your agenda for the July 21, 1992 meeting.

CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Ruggles called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

SCHEDULED AGENDA ITEMS

- Barbara Peterson - Request for relief from parking restrictions on Ocean Avenue, Harwich Port.

Barbara Peterson present and said it has been very stressful since the signs were placed there last year. She stated there usually no more than two cars there at a time.

Chief Greenwood stated he prefers to keep signs there, and has asked Ms. Peterson to submit a registration of one vehicle so no violations will be issued on that one car and other cars can park at the beach or CVS parking lot.

Mr. Melville was concerned with fire access if there were too many cars there.

Ms. Peterson stated there were no such problems in all the many years prior to the parking signs installed.

Motion made by Mrs. Gomes, seconded by Mrs. Daniels and so voted to recognize a hardship to Ms. Peterson's property and request the two no parking signs adjacent to 1 Ocean Avenue, be removed.
