To choose on one (1) ballot the following Town Officers and Committees: two (2) Selectmen for three (3) years; two (2) School Committee Members for three (3) years; four (4) Regional School Committee Members - two for a three (3) year term, one for a two (2) year term, and one for a one (1) year term, one (1) Water Commissioner for three (3) years; two (2) Library Trustees for three (3) years; one (1) Housing Authority Member for five (5) years.

Precinct I, Precinct II, Precinct III, and Precinct IV ballot boxes were examined by the Town Clerk and the Wardens of each precinct. Each ballot box was found to register "zero". The Town Clerk read the Warrant and Return of Warrant. At 7:00 A.M. the polls were then declared open.
