TRAFFIC SIGN PERMIT

Under authority of Chapter 89, Section 8 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition, the Department of Public Works hereby approves the installation of stop signs for the above location, provided that a permit for the opening of the road and the placing of structures thereon shall be received from the board or officer in charge of the road.

I LOCATION

Signs shall be located in strict accordance with Official Standards of the Department as set forth in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

II DESCRIPTION

Design: Identical with Official Department Standards as set forth in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

This is to certify that the installation of stop signs at the intersection listed above meets at least one of the following warrants as set forth in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices of the Department of Public Works, Commonwealth of Massachusetts:

(check applicable warrant(s))

- Intersection of a less important road with a main road where application of the normal right-of-way rule is unduly hazardous (two cross-type accidents in a one year period would be considered unduly hazardous)
- Unsignalized intersection in a signalized area.
- A combination of high speed, restricted view, and serious accident record indicates a need for control by the STOP sign.

This is to further certify that the street listed above under "Street Stopped" carries the lesser volume of traffic at this intersection.

OBEDIENCE TO ISOLATED STOP SIGNS. Every driver of a vehicle, railway car or other conveyance, approaching an intersection of ways where there exists facing him an official sign, bearing the word "stop" and authorized by this section, said sign having apart from this regulation, the written approval of the Department of Public Works, Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and such approval being in effect, shall before proceeding through the intersection, bring such vehicle, railway car or other conveyance to a complete stop at such point as may be clearly marked by a sign or line, or if a point is not so marked, then at a place between the said "stop" sign and the nearer line of the street intersection. In the case of a line of two or more vehicles approaching such "stop" sign, the drivers of the second and third vehicles in line in any group shall not be required to stop more than once before proceeding through the intersection. This section shall not apply when the traffic is otherwise directed by an officer or by a lawful traffic regulating sign, signal or device.

In accordance with the foregoing the erection and maintenance of an official "stop" sign or signs are authorized so as to face:

- Northbound drivers on Pine St. at Lower County Road
- North and southbound drivers on Brooks Road at Lower County Rd.
- North and southbound drivers on Earl Road at Lower County Rd.
- North and southbound drivers on Grey Neck Rd. at Lower County Rd.
- North and southbound drivers on Pleasant Rd. at Lower County Rd.
- Southbound drivers on Chase St. at Lower County Road
- Northbound drivers on Riverside Drive at Lower County Road
- North and southbound drivers on Belmont Road at Lower County Rd.
- East and westbound drivers on Willow St. at Belmont Road

PENALTY. Except as otherwise provided, any person convicted of a violation of any provision of these rules shall be punished by a fine of not more than two dollars (\$2.00) for the first offense and not more than twenty dollars (\$20.) for each subsequent offense of a like nature committed during any period of one year.



TRAFFIC SIGN PERMIT

Under authority of Chapter 357 Acts of 1928, as amended, the Department of Public Works hereby approves the following described traffic signs for the above location, provided that a permit for the opening of the road and the placing of structures thereon shall be received from the board or officer in charge of the road.

I LOCATION

Signs shall be located in strict accordance with Traffic Bulletin No. 3 and the attached drawing.

II DESCRIPTION

	(2)	Identical with Figure 12(d) Traffic Bulletin No. 3 except that wording shall be as follows.
	(3)	Identical with Figure Traffic Bulletin No. 3. except that the wording shall be omitted
	(4)	Different from any sign described in Bulletin No. 3 and in accordance with specifications shown on attached drawing.
