



HARWICH, MASSACHUSETTS

VOTED: As authorized by the General Laws and the Statutes of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to adopt the following amendments to the Town of Harwich Traffic Rules and Regulations in conjunction with the Safety Improvement Program (TOPICS):

A. PARKING PROHIBITED

✓ Bank Street: Easterly side from Route 28 to a point 190 feet northerly and from Route 28 to a point 100 feet southerly.

Westerly side from Route 28 to a point 200 feet southerly and from Route 28 to a point 250 feet northerly.

✓ Brooks Road: Westerly side of Brooks Road from Route 28 to a point 190 feet southerly.

Easterly side of Brooks Road from Route 28 to a point 150 feet southerly.

✓ Earle Road: Both sides from Route 28 to a point 200 feet southerly.

✓ Freeman Street: Both sides from Route 28 to a point 140 feet northerly.

✓ Lothrop Avenue: Both sides from Route 28 to a point 250 feet northerly.

✓ Sisson Road: Easterly side from Route 28 to a point 220 feet northerly.

✓ Westerly side from Route 28 to a point 100 feet northerly.

B. STOP SIGNS

To be installed in accordance with permits filed by the Town of Harwich and approved by the Massachusetts Department of Public Works.

C. ONE WAY OPERATION

Location 4 Along the section of Gordon Ritchie Road from
Lower County Road to Belmont Road.

D. MANDATORY LEFT TURN. "LEFT LANE MUST TURN LEFT" SIGN

Location 3E Left for southbound drivers on Sisson Road
into Route 28.
