HARWICH, MASSACHUSETTS

"Voted that the Traffic Rules and Orders of the Town of Harwich adopted by the Board of Selectmen July 1, 1940 and subsequent amendments thereto be and are hereby further amended as follows:

By striking out in Article VIII, Section 8 the following description

Eastbound drivers on Great Western Road at Old Chatham Road.

By adding at the end of Article VIII the following new section:

SECTION 13 OBEDIENCE TO YIELD SIGNS

Every driver of a vehicle or other conveyance approacing an intersection of ways, where there exists facing him an official sign beating the word "Yield" said sign having been erected in accordance with the written approval of the Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and such approval being in effect, shall surrender to oncoming traffic his right to enter the intersection until such time as he has brought his vehicle or other conveyance to a complete stop at a point between the said "Yield" sign and the nearer line of the street intersection, provided, however, that this requirement to stop before entering the intersection shall not apply when a driver approacing a "Yield" sign can enter the intersection in safety without causing interference to approaching traffic.

This section shall not apply when the traffic is otherwise directed by an officer or by a lawful traffic regulating sign, signal or device or as provided in Section 11(b) of this Article.

In accordance with the foregoing, the erection and maintenance of official "Yield" signs are authorized so as to face:

Eastbound drivers on Great Western Road at Old Chatham Road.

TRAFFIC SIGN PERMIT

Under authority of Chapter. 89. Section. 8... of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition, the Department of Public Works hereby approves the following described traffic signs for the above location, provided that a permit for the opening of the road and the placing of structures thereon shall be received from the board or officer in charge of the road.

I LOCATION

Signs shall be located in strict accordance with Official Standards of the Department.

II DESCRIPTION

- (a) Design*(1) Identical with Official Department Standards.
 - (2) Different from any sign described in Official Department Standards and in accordance with specifications shown on attached drawing.
