- Intersection of a less important road with a main road where application of the normal right-of-way rule is unduly hazardous (two cross-type accidents in a one year period would be considered unduly haverdous)
- Unsignalized intersection in a signalized area.
- A combination of high speed, restricted view, and serious accident report indicates a peak for coutrol by the BUCP sign.
