# ROUTE 137 - SOUTHBOUND

Peginning at the Brewster Town Line Thence southerly on Route 137

0.19 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the beginning of State Highway, (Long Pond Drive):

And beginning again at the end of State Highway, (Pleasant Tay Rd.) Thence southerly on Route 137

0.93 miles at 40 miles per hour

0.23 " " 30 " " " " 0.45 " " 35 " " "

0.07 " " 20 " " ending at Queen Ann

Road; the total distance being 1.87 miles.
