## Items

- 1. Previous Meeting Minutes (1-26-18)
  - a. Chris Clark made motion to approve, Paul McCormick seconded. Vote unanimous.
- 2. Town Updates
  - a. Dennis
    - i. Dennis WIC supported Draft DHY Town Meeting Article
    - ii. DHY Article will be discussed at Selectmen's Meeting in March
    - iii. Dennis had meeting with Senator Cyr and Representative Whelan related to Airbnb tax. Sent message that Dennis wants money returned directly back to town.
    - iv. Dennis held a meeting with the Chamber of Commerce to discuss increasing hotel/motel tax from 4% to 6%. Will be meeting with constituents to discuss planning for this in the future. This is part of their wastewater cost recovery plan education effort.
  - b. Harwich
    - i. DHY Article on the Town Meeting Warrant
    - Wastewater Support Committee (WSC) held meeting and is preparing for Annual Town Meeting request for sewer construction funds for East Harwich. Meeting three times per month leading up to Town Meeting.
      WSC meetings are televised.



- iii. Harwich Chamber of Commerce is notifying membership of the Town Meeting Articles. The Chamber volunteered to display educational material about the project.
- iv. The Wastewater Support Committee is going to host an event with the Chamber of Commerce and local banks to discuss financing options for homeowners to connect to the sewer.
- v. The Town of Harwich Board of Health is preparing to discuss options for septic system replacement when sewers are anticipated to come down a street in the future.
- vi. Wastewater Governance on Warrant proposing to switch to Water/Sewer for the O&M of the sewer system after construction. Selectmen will oversee projects until construction is completed.
- c. Yarmouth
  - i. Presented DHY Town Meeting Article to BOS; consensus to support.
  - ii. In 1984, Yarmouth adopted BOS as Sewer Commissioners
- 3. Review Draft Special Legislation Town Meeting Article (revised by John Giorgio, K P Law)
  - a. Yarmouth Town Counsel has a minor edit to the DHY Special Legislation Article and will discuss with John Giorgio
  - b. Discussed Special Legislation used in MFN for DHY
- 4. Review Community Compact Grant Award Revised Scope of Work, Budget, and Schedule
  - a. DHY Grant Press Release is ready and will go out early next week
  - b. Yarmouth reviewed and approved revised Scope of Work, Budget, and Schedule
- 5. Preparation for March 22<sup>nd</sup> Meeting with Three Towns
  - a. Yarmouth has invited members of the state delegation including Dan Sieger, Millie Garcia Serrano, Gary Moran, A&F Deputy Commissioner, etc.
  - b. MassDEP Commissioner has drafted an editorial discussing the Cape's efforts on wastewater and will be releasing in March
  - c. Review of Agenda and Flyer
  - d. DHY Working group will sit together upfront at meeting
  - e. Separate press release to announce March 22<sup>nd</sup> Meeting
  - f. DHY Administrators to have conference call with local newspapers to discuss upcoming meeting once the press release is issued.

  - a. Study identified economic areas in town and discussed jobs created and that money spent on wastewater will lead to greater economic spending including job growth.
  - b. Yarmouth interested in performing an economic study for Route 28 and include impacts on housing prices.
- 7. Preliminary Route 6 Bridge Widening Benefits
  - a. Discussions need to be continued with high level administrative support of MassDOT. Communities will send a letter requesting a meeting to discuss.
  - b. Permitting and designing first may be helpful to expedite the project
- 8. Topics for Future Meetings
  - a. Potential Grant/Loan Program Opportunities
    - i. Yarmouth previously met with Mass Development to discuss grant opportunities. Need to consider part time jobs in addition to full time job equivalent created.

  - d. Invite Legislative Delegation to next DHY monthly meeting to discuss Airbnb
